Please note the dates and timing of his/her papers as well as the following arrangements:

- 1. Your child will **report to school as per normal (including even week Wednesday) by 0720** and he/she will be dismissed from school after the last paper that he/she is sitting for each day.
- 2. We appreciate your assistance in ensuring that your child/ward revises his/her work. It is compulsory for your child/ward to sit for the End-of-Year Examination as it forms a significant component of the overall results at the end of the year.
- 3. Attendance for the End-of-Year Examination is compulsory. Pupils who are absent from any papers, must produce a medical certificate the following day without which, pupils will be deemed as absent without valid reason and no marks will be given for the examinations. However, if your child/ward is unwell on any examination day and having a fever or exhibiting Acute Respiratory Infection(ARI) symptoms, he/she should self-test using an ART kit. If your child/ward is tested Ag+, he/she should not come to school to sit for the papers. In this case, this will be considered as valid reasons and no MC is required to support his/her absences. Please get your child/ward to alert and submit a picture of his/her Ag+ result to his/her Form Teachers. If your child/ward is tested AG- and is unwell to seat for the paper, he/she will have to obtain a MC from a medical doctor and present the MC for his/her absence for the paper.
