Secondary 4NA/NT Preliminary Examinations 2022

Please be informed that the **Preliminary Examination** will be conducted from **11 to 22 August 2022**. A copy of your child's/ward's Preliminary Examination timetable is attached.

Please note the dates and timing of the papers as well as the following arrangements:

1. **Your child will report to school as normal (including Mondays) by 0720** and will be dismissed from school after the last paper that he/she is sitting for each day.

We appreciate your assistance in ensuring that your child/ward revises his/her work. It is compulsory for your child/ward to sit for the Preliminary Examination as assessment is integral to the learning process and provides evidence about student learning to check for their understanding and support them in attaining the learning outcomes.

2. **Attendance for the Preliminary Examinations is compulsory. Pupils who are absent from any papers, must produce a medical certificate the following day without which, pupils will be deemed as absent without valid reason and no marks will be given for the examinations.** However, due to the current Covid-19 situation, if your child/ward is unwell on any examination day and having a fever or exhibiting Acute Respiratory Infection(ARI) symptoms, he/she should self-test for Ag+ prior to coming for the papers. If your child/ward is tested Ag+, he/she should not come to school to sit for the papers. In this case, this will be considered as valid reasons and no MC is required to support his/her absences. **Please get your child/ward to alert and submit a picture of his/her Ag+ result to his/her Form Teachers.**

3. **Kindly note that your child/ward is not required to come to school on this day:**
